- 6. No necessity for rotation of crops; the potatoes can be thus grown almost indefinitely on the same land, with perhaps, at long intervals, a seeding of clover to maintain the supply of vegetable fibre in the soil.
- 7. No loss by late spring frosts. If the early growth is cut off, the dormant eyes will grow and the crop be saved.
  - 8. The greatest economy of culture and harvesting.
  - 9. The highest table quantity of potatoc.

If the materials for the compact cannot be obtained, top-dress heavily in the fall, after plowing, with barn manure, but never use it in the season of planting. It may increase the crop, but tends to engeuder disease, especially in wet seasons.
